

Apartment Hunting Checklist for LA Renters (2025 Edition)

Before You Search

- [] Check your credit score (aim for 600+ or prepare alternatives)
- [] Calculate your monthly budget using the 50/30/20 rule
- [] Get pre-approved or gather proof of income
- [] List your must-haves (e.g., in-unit laundry, pet-friendly, parking)
- [] Set your max rent limit (don't forget utilities, deposits)

While Browsing Listings

- [] Use trusted platforms: Zillow, HotPads, Apartments.com
- [] Compare neighborhoods (consider traffic, amenities, safety)
- [] Save top 5-10 units with price, size, and move-in date
- [] Create a spreadsheet or use a free Notion template
- [] Check for red flags (e.g., vague descriptions, no photos)

During Virtual or In-Person Tours

- [] Inspect unit condition (walls, windows, appliances)
- [] Ask about lease length, rent increases, and utilities
- [] Test water pressure, outlets, and cell signal
- [] Look at the building/community (noise, security, parking)
- [] Review online reviews on Google or Reddit

Before You Apply

- [] Confirm all costs: rent, deposit, fees, parking, pet rent
- [] Prepare ID, proof of income, and references
- [] Ask if application fees are refundable
- [] Understand the lease terms and early termination policy
- [] Be ready to apply quickly (units move fast!)
